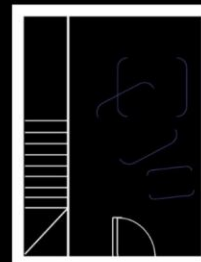


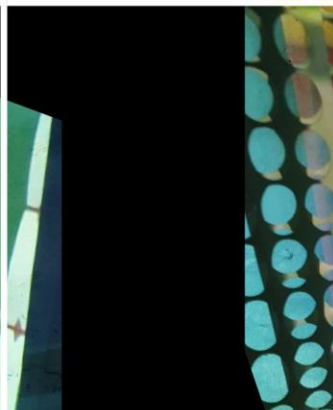
# BASEMENT 63

Stage 2 of escalating the visual importance of mundane, unassuming materials categorised as industrial packaging as they become anti-materials. The artist and curator examine the ready-mades of factory leftovers and synthesise every factor through their mechanical characteristics. Sculpture and light act as the moulding framework for these discarded forms, as the machinery moves through the media into the present space.



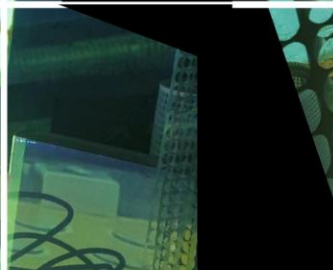
Unfortunately, there is no disabled access at the gallery.

The projections depict the original factory process, playing the robotic motions of the cogs turning to retain the material origin of these salvaged plastic and cardboard objects.

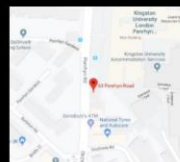
